

DESITE BIM 2.8.3

has been released today, 29th July 2021.
The installer will be available on DESITE BIM downloads.

Release Highlights

NEW FEATURES:

- **IFC Import**
 - Line objects without faces (e.g. spatial curves) can now also be imported.
- **CPIXML Import**
 - Objects with the xml attribute "refID" are no longer automatically recognised as cut parts (DESITE internal) if the xml attribute "negative" is missing.
- **DB performance improvements**

IMPROVEMENTS:

- **Attribute Check**
 - For a set of rules, the checks are not aborted after the first failure; all rules are checked (logical 'or').
- **Smart Sets**
 - Fixed a bug that sometimes empty containers were not deleted after applying a filter rule.
- **Clash Detection/Model check: Create reports and viewpoints**
 - It is now possible to abort the creation process.
- **Open Project from CPA file**
 - The erroneous overwriting of existing projects or project data was made more difficult by a confirmation when unpacking into a non-empty directory.
- **Model Versions**
 - Fixed an error which could occur when comparing properties in combination with the use of project repository properties
- **IFC Export**
 - By mistake, properties (depending on the selection of the PropertyProvider) could be written twice in a PropertySet, this error is fixed
 - For property types used for the ifc type mapping, formulas ("=") now are also evaluated
- **Data Sheet and Quickinfo**
 - The values of evaluated formulas are now displayed as configured in the object hierarchies.
- **ID Check**
 - Fixed a crash which could occur when using context menu action "scroll to element".
 - Sets elements visible/invisible in hierarchy of other domains than geometry.
